The recipient will be chosen from applications received by the Mulberry-Fairplains Ruritan Club Scholarship Committee and will be based on the applicant's need and on the potential of academic success as determined from past performance records provided by the applicant to the Mulberry-Fairplains Ruritan Club Scholarship Committee.

Applications for consideration for this grant must be submitted to the Mulberry-Fairplains Ruritan Club Scholarship Committee by April 30 of the first year of the requested grant award. Only complete applications will be considered. Grant qualifications and requirements are listed on the application form. Notification of award will be made by May 15.

Completed applications must be provided to any one of the Mulberry-Fairplains Ruritan Scholarship Committee by the stated deadlines. Application kits may be obtained at the North Wilkes High School Guidance Center. An official application form must be used in the application process. Copied forms will not be considered. ONLY COMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED.
